

JARS Shack rental terms and conditions.

The shack is available on a first-come first-served basis. Confirmed reservations will be filled first.

Use of the Club Station is ONLY available to club members. Overseas membership is available to non-residents of Jersey – Currently £10.00 per year.

Use of any of the club callsigns [GJ3DVC, GJ8RVT or GJ2A] requires that each person who wishes to operate must be a licensed amateur. To verify this each operator will be required to provide a photocopy of their licence. Licences MUST be CEPT compliant, a foreign licence recognised by OFCOM or an OFCOM (British) issued reciprocal licence. **Licences that do not conform to these requirements will NOT allow an operator to transmit.**

A rental charge of £60.00 is payable for each operation by overseas members. Full club members who wish to use the club for contest purposes shall make a donation of not less than £20.00 to the club.

The electricity meter will be read upon your arrival and again prior to your departure. Normal consumption (by the cell site and background heating) will be deducted. Any significant power consumption will be charged at the Jersey Electricity Company standard rates.

A booked operation may ordinarily consist of up to seven consecutive days.

To persons not known to the club a deposit of £200.00 is required. This will be returned following an inspection to ensure the club is left in a clean and tidy condition and all equipment is connected and operational as it was prior to the operation.

Accommodation in a hotel, guesthouse or campsite MUST be booked for the duration of your stay. The clubhouse is not permitted to provide accommodation for visitors.

Unless an arrangement has been made in advance, priority is to be given to club members who may wish to use the shack on club nights (currently Wednesday and Friday 20:00 – 22:30)

Any damage must be repaired or paid for. There are NO exceptions to this.

The GJ2A callsign is ONLY available for use during certain specified contests. It may NOT be used before or after the contest.

If any of the club Callsigns are used, GJ3DVC, GJ2A or GJ8RVT – an electronic copy of the log must be emailed to the club in ADIF format.

ADSL Internet connection is available in the club. Changing of ANY of the ADSL router parameters is strictly forbidden.

The management committee of the club may vary these terms and conditions at any time.

An up-to-date version of these terms and conditions will be posted at the club and on the club web site at www.gj3dvc.org.je.

QSL Cards.

If you use your own call, MJ/owncall or a British call with the GJ or MJ prefix YOU are responsible for providing the Jersey QSL manager with envelopes for cards.

If you use a club callsign the **ONLY** QSL information is via QRZ.com (to GJ3DVC QTHR) You may NOT circulate ANY other address via the Internet or any reflector.
